



APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF STANDARDBRED HORSES WITH SPPHA NSW

Registration provides official identification of the horse, which may be requested for equestrian competitions and/or breed classes by event/show committees. It also officially identifies a person as the owner of the horse. Note that, for Standardbreds, HRA (Harness Racing Australia) papers may also serve a similar purpose.

Please note the following in regards to registration with SPPHA NSW:

- Applications for registration will only be accepted from financial members of SPPHA NSW. If you are not a financial member and wish to register your horse with SPPHA NSW, follow our link on our membership page or head directly to Nominate.com.au
- *There is no limit to the number of horses that may be registered except for junior members, where the limit is 2 horses.*
- Registration is for the life of the horse. Registration issued by another Standardbred association is acceptable and, in such situations, additional registration with SPPHA NSW may not be required. Please contact SPPHA NSW to discuss.
- Definitions of registration, eligibility for competition and requirements for association membership may differ with other Standardbred associations. Please check with these organisations to confirm their requirements if competing outside NSW.

To complete the registration process:

- Apply for membership (through Nominate) if you're not already a member.
- Complete ALL of the horse information on the first page of the registration form. With the freezebrand or racing name of the horse, you can find this information at www.harness.org.au/hra.cfm (see attached pages).
 - If you are not registering the horse using their HRA-Registered name, or if the horse is unnamed, please provide 5 alternative names in order of preference. While SPPHA NSW allows registration with your choice of name, the name cannot be the same as that of a horse already registered with HRA or SPPHA NSW.
- Complete the diagram on the second page of the registration form with your horse's white markings, brands and scars.
- Please provide the following photographs of your horse, without saddlery or harness:
 - A clear close up photograph of your horse's brand. If horse is in winter coat, please clip the brand area for ease of reading.
 - A full body side-on view of the off-side of the horse, clearly showing the horse's freeze brand on the neck.
 - A full body side-on view of the near-side of the horse.
 - Clear photo/photos showing placement of any white markings i.e. face, legs.

Searching for Horse Pedigree Information

- Access the HRA Database www.harness.org.au/hra.cfm

- Decide which type of search to use – Find exact name (horse’s racing name), General Search for Name, or Freezebrand:
 - Freezebrand is the most specific and accurate way to search (clip the freezebrand for ease of reading). You will have to convert the symbols to numbers
 - See <http://www.standardbred.org.au/page8.php> for how to read the freezebrand.
 - Australian and New Zealand freezebrands use similar principles with codes but use different symbols (“Alpha Angle” vs “TVI”) and are formatted differently.
 - Racing name can also be effective; BUT:
 - names may be spelt the way they sound rather than “correctly” (e.g. Fierydolabill rather than Fiery Dollar Bill).
 - be aware of the NZ suffix for NZ-bred horses (e.g. “Find exact name” search for “Shalom Bromac” will give you “horse not found”; you would have to search as “Shalom Bromac NZ” or use the “General Search for Name”).
- General search is best performed only for unusual names; the database search will only list up to 50 names (so don’t use this search if you think your horse has “Hanover” or “Adios” in his racing name).



- A successful search will take you to a summary information page. This will show Sire, Dam and Broodmare Sire only.

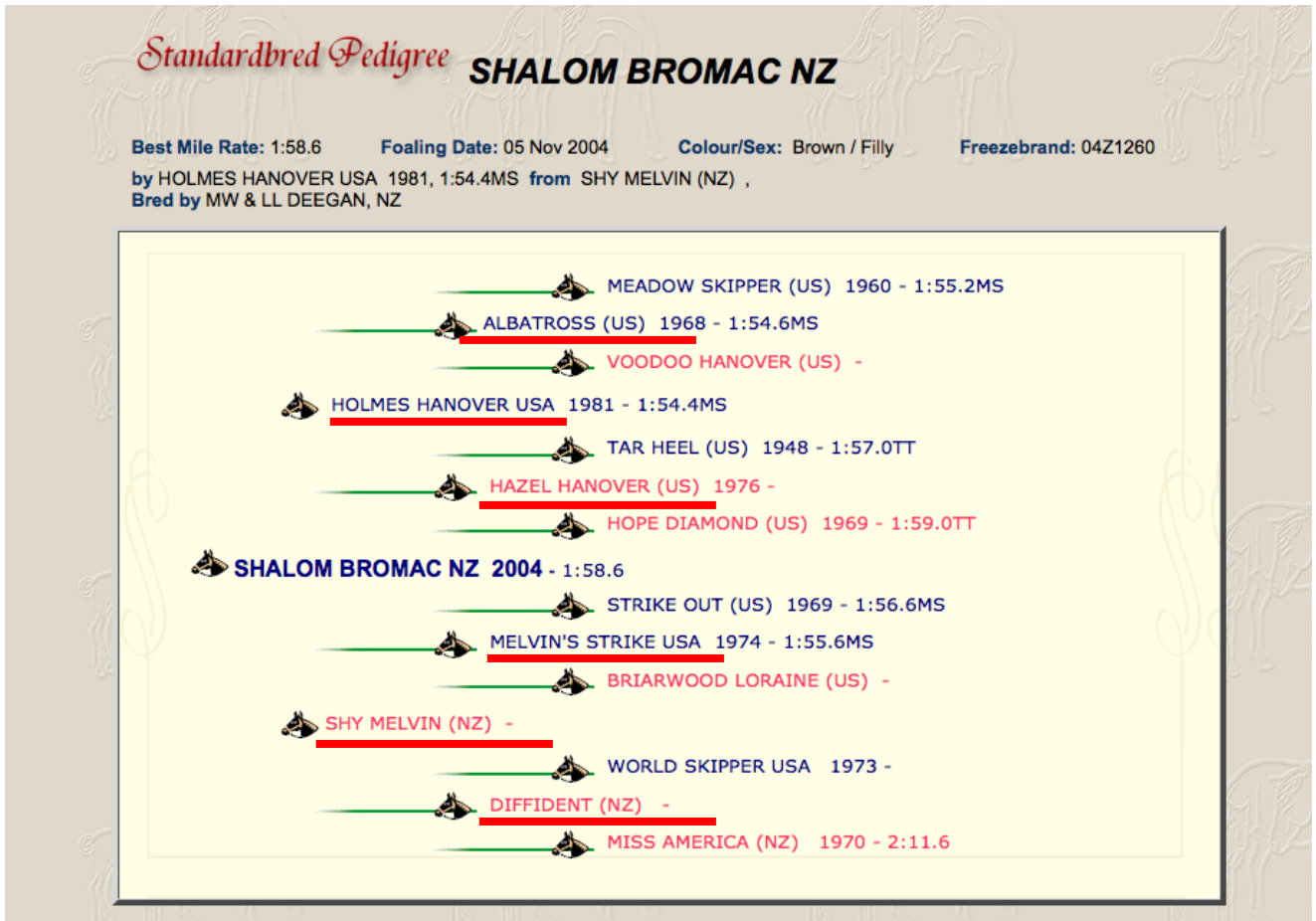

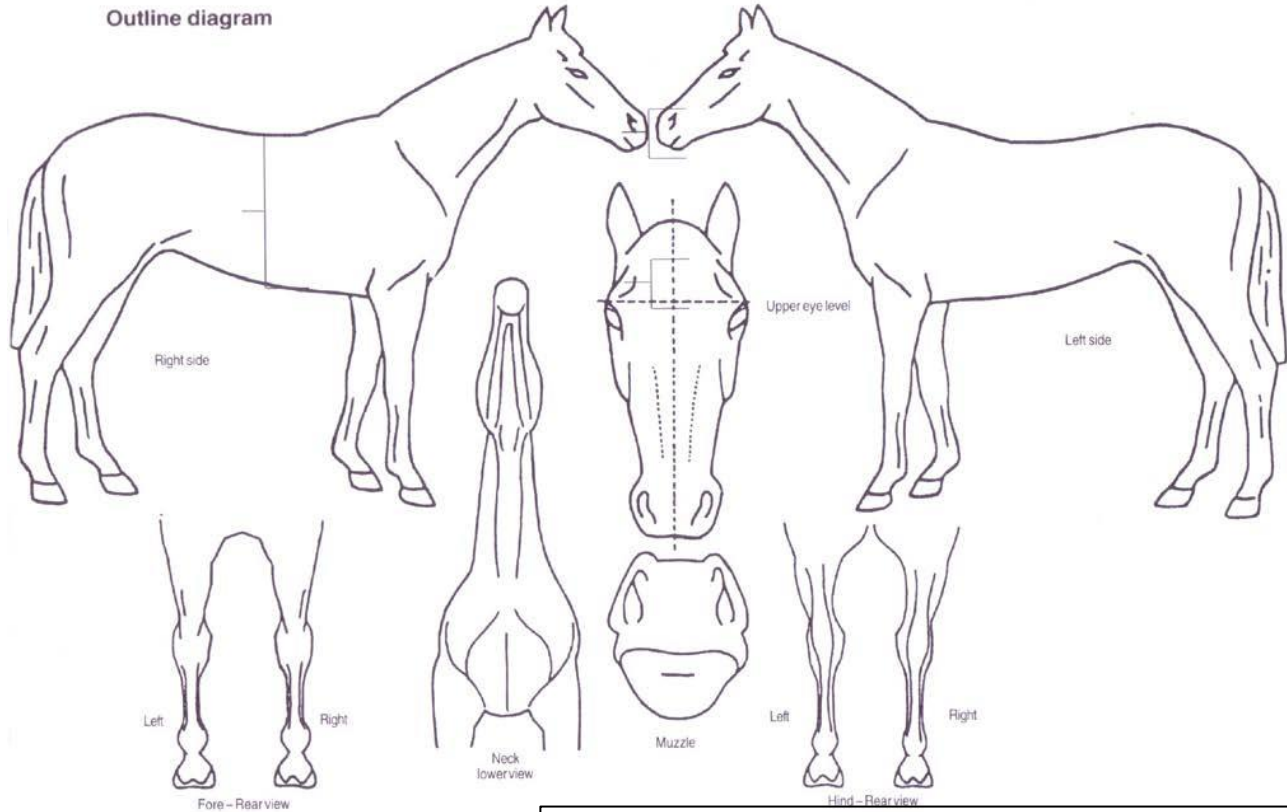
