



## STANDBRED NATIONAL HIGH POINT COMPETITION 2019 –2020

NOW WITH ADDED SPONSORSHIP FROM MAXISOY AUSTRALIA



Members of the Australian Standardbred Pleasure Horse Associations are invited to take part in the 2019 - 2020 Standardbred National High Point Competition, members-only, showing competition. The competition offers 2 JUNIOR sections for younger members showing mares or geldings and 3 SENIOR sections for members, 18 years and over, showing mares, geldings or stallions.

This, unique to the Standardbred, low cost national competition does not require interstate travel, it all happened in your home state.

Each state association, participating in this competition, nominates shows that offer led and ridden classes that lead to a Supreme Led Exhibit sash presentation and a Ridden Champion sash presentation. **Entrants MUST choose 4** of the 8 nominated shows below.

The Confirmed NSW Shows are as follows:

- **Penrith Annual Ag Show 25<sup>th</sup> August 2019**
- **Menangle Annual Ag Show 6<sup>th</sup> October 2019**
- **Cootamundra Annual Ag Show 19<sup>th</sup> October 2019**
- **National Capital Horse Show 24<sup>th</sup> November 2019**
- **Cessnock Annual Ag Show 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020**
- **Luddenham Annual Ag Show 7<sup>th</sup> March 2020**
- **Goulburn Annual Ag Show 7<sup>th</sup> March 2020**
- **Hawkesbury Annual Ag Show 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2020**

To contest this competition, just fill in the entry form on the attached sheet and return it with entry fees of \$20 for each section you wish to contest – either led or ridden or both. The maximum entry fee is \$40.

You will be issued with a National High Point performance card. This card is to be taken to **your nominated 4 shows** from the above list, where you are to record your placings and have the card signed by the judge or ring steward. All cards are to be returned to the SPPHA NSW PO Box by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020. Unsigned cards will be deemed unacceptable.

Point allocations will be as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> place	4 points	Supreme	10 points	These points are not accumulative. The horse that is awarded a Supreme can only achieve 10 points, a Champion 8 points, a Reserve 6 points. 1 <sup>st</sup> place and no Champion, or Supreme will achieve 4 points, etc.
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	3 points	Champion	8 points	
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	2 points	Reserve	6 points	
4 <sup>th</sup> place	1 point			

Achievement sashes will be presented to the Top-5 in each section as follows:

### **Juniors – handler/rider to be under 18 years of age on 1 July 2019**

### **Seniors – handler/rider to be 18 years or over on 1 July 2019**

Senior Led Gelding                      Senior Led Mare                      Senior Led Stallion  
 Senior Ridden Gelding                Senior Ridden Mare                Senior Ridden Stallion

- Competitors who do not place Top 5 receive a complimentary Participation Sash.
- National Championship sashes will be presented to the led and ridden horses, in each section (junior and senior), with the highest points – 10 Championships on offer.
- National High Point Performance Horse sashes will be presented to the horse, in each section (junior and senior), with the highest combined (led and ridden) points. In the event of a draw of points for a National High Point Performance Horse there will be a count of all horses competed against at the four nominated shows i.e. number of geldings, mares and stallions leading

up to each Supreme or Champion. We are sorry but there can only be one National High Point Performance Horse in each section.

- We have a new sponsorship for all Champions and the 2 National Performance Horses, from **Maxisoy Australia**.
- With funds coming from entry fees, Horseland vouchers, valued at \$25, will be presented to the 10 Champions and the 2 National Performance Horses will receive vouchers valued at \$100 each. All entry fees for this competition are returned to the competitors – the more entries the greater the value returned

We are also hoping to secure further, outside sponsorship for this year's competitions; if this is successful members will be advised and prize values increased.
